## Senior Care Wellness program

“For the Health of your Pet”

### For dogs and cats, 7 years and older

Your pet may SEEM healthy well into its senior years. Nonetheless, there are many problems common to geriatric pets, which may not present symptoms until your pet becomes tragically ill. Research has shown that about 30% of our senior pets do not show any clinical sign of disease; however, with a full clinical examination, including a tailor made blood profile your vet can identify disease processes early and start with preventative treatment before the disease progresses to a debilitating or fatal stage.

### Conditions commonly seen in older pets include:

- Chronic Renal Disease
- Neoplasia
- Arthritis
- Cardiac Disease
- Dental Disease
- Digestive abnormalities
- Obesity (including Diabetes and Hypothyroidism)
- Chronic Hepatopathy
- Genital Disease (Uterine/Prostatic)
- Sensory Loss (Cataracts and deafness)
- Bronchial Disease
- Hyperthyroidism (cats)

### What does the Senior Wellness Program involve?

#### Annually

- Comprehensive Physical and Dental Exam
- Blood work (Complete Blood Count, Blood Chemistry Panel to assess internal organ function)
- Urinalysis
- Faecal Analysis
- General Anesthesia and Dental Scale and Polish
- X-rays of chest (Heart and Lung Conditions), also Pelvis, Back, Knees and Elbows for Arthritis
- FeLV/FIV (Feline Patients)
- Annual Vaccination
- Deworming
- Tick and flea treatment

### How do I enroll my pet?

- Call us to arrange a day for your pet to receive his/her testing.
- Please withhold food from your pet from 10pm the night before so that we can get an accurate blood sample.
- Make water available as usual
- Admit your pet to the hospital by 07h30
- We will schedule a discharge appointment between 15h00 and 18h00 the same day to review the test results with you and discuss any appropriate care and treatment for your pet.
- Fill in our Senior pet questionnaire

- kidney disease,
- malignant and benign tumours,

However, when such conditions are diagnosed in their early stages, treatment to cure such disorders or delay their progress can be given in most cases. For that reason, we recommend that all our dog and cat patients that are 7 years or older, have an annual geriatric evaluation.
